Minutes

Members of public speak:

Mark Pearson: was given questions to ask by people that weren't there. Hope to have more in person meetings.

Karla Leppen: When does this go onto a plan commission agenda

Dave Mangin: One issue we didn't get to in person was the flag poles. Figures we'd have a flag pole just wasn't in rendering

Public input sessions review and next steps.

- Concerned about location of Village Hall was more concern than if there needs to be one.
- Jerry Dunn's location might actually be a viable alternative. Same size as current design.
- Both are central locations. Park has the benefit of having kids playing in park during meetings.
- Can Dave do a similar design for Jerry's site? Yes, by all means. And Jerry has a lot of design ideas already.
- Gimme Shelter is providing \$2500 worth of design time and Dave is donating additional time and that allocation is close to being exhausted.
- 2 years ago at least since we heard about a new Village hall going in park.
- Young families see a benefit and like the multi-functional use appeals to them.
- You get benefits at the park that you don't get at any other site.
- Civic pride – need something nice.
- Objections to park site: Safety. Park is a park. You don't need to destroy it. You don't need buildings. Might have been interested in this a few years ago, but now with what is going on in society, now way – Gale
- Karla – Thinks that asking the public about this is a good idea, but that calling it a survey is a bad idea. Prefers that it be a referendum.
- Survey – Question could be asked – given 2or3 options, which would you prefer? Gives additional opportunity for input. Might ease some tensions. Dan would need to be the one to make sure that every one is just voting once. This seems worthwhile to everyone and Josh will work with Dan.
- Village Hall at post office – add cost with two stories – additional concrete, stairs, etc. Doesn't have the upside of park location. Unknown whether septic and well can serve 3 different buildings. Well at least needs service if not replacement.
- Bobby looking at septic and pump tank for fire hall.
- Look at where plan commission fits into schedule for this.
