Resolution # 2018-08-15-2

A Resolution to revise local legal posting locations.

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statute 985.01(7), 985.02 (2) (a), 985.02 (2) (b), 985.02 (2) (c), 985.02 (3) and 985.08 (1) provide a method of notification of legal notices; and

WHEREAS, Under previous law, a municipality must post notice in at least three public places likely to give notice to persons affected, and must post a notice that would be published before the act or event requiring notice no later than the time specified for the first newspaper publication, or if the notice would be published after the act or event requiring notice, must post the notice within one week after the act or event; and

WHEREAS, Under 2015 Senate Bill 137, signed into law on November 11, 2015, a municipality that opts to post a legal notice in lieu of publication may, instead of posting the notice in three public places, post the notice in one public place and publish the notice on the municipality's Internet site;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Nelsonville, Portage County, Wisconsin does hereby consider our Village website and the posting board at the Nelsonville Post Office to be our legal posting locations.

This resolution repeals any previous resolutions or ordinances pertaining to the village's posting locations.
